I write to express my opposition to Powys Local Health Board's proposals for future services in the Builth Wells area.

The proposals remove many services, especially inpatient and associated facilities from Builth Hospital. There seems no coherent or logical plan for how or where those services will be provided in the future.

Inpatient beds must remain at Builth Hospital. I urge you to consult openly, without contempt for the views of the clinicians and community, and to build on the services provided here to improve the healthcare of the area, not condemn it to second-rate provision.

Your proposals seem driven mainly by the need to save money and will result in a worsening of health facilities for the Builth and Llanwrtyd Wells locality.

Think again.

You are ill informed and out of touch with the population you serve.

I would be grateful for a written reply to this letter, detailing how you intend to reprovide the services that are being withdrawn and also what you will do when your current plans are defeated?
